The Ayala High School Band and Color Guard is proud to host their 5th Annual Music in Motion Field Tournament, a Western Band Association (WBA) adjudicated show, at the Ayala High School Stadium, 14255 Peyton Drive in Chino Hills on Saturday, October 15, 2011. Opening ceremonies will begin at 1:00 p.m.

This family event is fun and exciting as twenty five outstanding High School Marching Bands and Auxiliary from throughout California compete for scores and placement by presenting outstanding musical and visual performances. Over 3000 performers will be in attendance. Bands vary in size from 48 to 208 members, as does the complexity of their musical and visual shows. In addition to the competition, Riverside Community College Marching Tigers will perform in exhibition. Ayala's Music In Motion Tournament is one of several competitions leading to the WBA Statewide Championships to be held late November 2011, in Santa Barbara, California.

Admission to this event is \$10 for adults, \$7 for children ages 5-12 and seniors over 65 and Military personnel (with proper identification). Children under age 5 are free. Food, drink, and souvenirs will be available for purchase. All proceeds from the show help and support the Ayala Band and Color Guard in purchasing musical instruments and equipment.

The Ayala High School Band and Color Guard is under the direction of Mr. Mark Stone. Ayala earned the title of WGI Scholastic World Percussion Champions – 2010, WGI Scholastic World Concert Percussion Champions – 2006, 2007, 2009 and 2010, BOA Grand National Finalist – 2004, BOA Regional Champions – 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, and 2010.
